- > To take care of workload of existing teachers and their positions.
- The pattern which we are going to adopt for the science and technology and for commerce and Arts should be spelled out in a different manner because for Science and Technology, theory and practical element is much more than arts and science.
- > College can incorporate the practicals to arts and Commerce, but it can be done by taking consultation from dignitaries of the affiliating university,

especially from the education field and the examination section of the affiliating University.

Dr Shubhada Nayak informed that, the pattern for Arts and Commerce is prepared as per the guidelines of UGC.

- 3. Dr.Pratibha Gaikwad shared latest guide lines of the Central Government for permission to start NCC, in which there is increase in number of seats for the Coastal area and suggested to apply for permission under coastal area segment.
- 4. Dr. Vitthal Shivankar asked to give details of MOU with American Indian Foundation and activities from the collaboration. Dr. Shubhada Nayak explained the vision, mission and objectives of the Foundation and its activities in our country. She explained the project of the AIF 'Ecosystem for Employability' which is very structured programme under which our college is chosen as a hub for Thane District for giving training and placement to minimum 300 students having commerce or IT background. Dr. Shivankar Sir Congratulated about this international collaboration.
- 5. Dr. Shivankar also asked about the progress of registration of CIII, Kharghar under Section 8 of the Company Act. Dr. Shubhada Madam explained the progress of registration work.
