 - Preparation and sale of readymade reagents / kits and laboratory media.
- c) The students have an option to go for further studies in B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. (Microbiology, Zoology, Botany, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Life Sciences, Geology.)

3. Construction Technology (CT)

The student on completing XII the CT course is eligible for

- a) Self-employment as a registered Government contractor, subcontractors, labour contractor and maintenance consultants.
- b) He / She can be a Building construction supervisor, Material testing lab assistant, Quality control supervisor.
- c) The student passing XIIth std with this course, securing first class can get admission directly to II year diploma in Civil Engineering or B.A./B.Com.





JUNIOR COLLEGE ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Admissions are made as per merit and other norms laid down by the Govt. of Maharashtra, from time to time. Students are advised to go through the guidelines and admission notices, before seeking admission in the college.

- A) Students who have passed S.S.C. examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education will be admitted for the First Year Jr. College classes without producing eligibility.
- B) Students who have passed S.S.C. Examination from any other Board in India will be admitted to the Higher Secondary Std XIth provided they have offered English as one of the Subjects.
 - Prescribed application form of H.S.C. Board for obtaining Eligibility Certificate
 - In Statement of Marks of the Previous Examination.
 - Passing Certificate of the Previous Examination.
 - School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate with Counter signature of Education Officer.
 - Adhar Card xerox copy.
 - Migration Certificate in original (In case there is no practice of issuing the Migration Certificate by the Examination Board or Body.)
 - Certificate in the prescribed Appendix A' (for abroad candidate seeking admission in the Jr. College situated in the state of Maharashtra under the jurisdiction of this Board.)
- C) For new admission to the Second Year Jr. College class, a student will have to produce a certificate from recognised institution of the effect that the student concerned has passed the Annual Examination held by it at the end of the First Year of Jr. College.
- D) A student failed in XIth & XIIth class will not be given admission in the same class again.

Rules For The Admission To F.Y. J. C. (XI)th Class

- Admission will be made as per guidelines given by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
- The Students whose names appear in the Eligible merit list will have to take admission within the time limit displayed on the notice-board/Gov. website. If he/she fails to do so his/her admission will be cancelled.
- Admission process will be stopped immediately after the required number of students are admitted.
- The decision of the Admission Committee will be final.
- Once a student is admitted to Jr. College, he/she is liable to pay prescribed full fee.





JUNIOR COLLEGE ADMISSION GUIDELINES

- All admissions are valid for only one academic year and are required to be renewed with application in the prescribed form for the subsequent academic year.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

Campus

The college has sprawling campus of 5 acres, of which 2.4 acres is the playground. It has 10,000Sq. m², of construction distributed in four buildings viz. Administrative Building, Main Building, Library Building and Women's Hostel. The entire campus is under constant surveillance of CCTV camera for safety and well being of students and staff.

Classrooms: The Classrooms are spacious, well ventilated and are spanned in all the three buildings of the college campus. Some classrooms are equipped with smart boards LCD projectors and screens for audio-visual presentations.

Laboratories: There are separate laboratories for each science subject and for Junior and Senior college classes. Most laboratories are air-conditioned and have all necessary equipments. Postgraduate and Research Laboratories are equipped with sophisticated instruments which are well maintained for use all throughout the year. There are seven computer laboratories with around 500 computers with latest software. Safety in laboratory is taken care of with the help of laboratory attendants and fire extinguishers.

women's hostel can accommodate approximately 90 girls. Its modern architecture and clean surroundings are highly

Play ground: Spread over 2.5 acres, the play ground has facilities for cricket,

equipped with modern equipments and is free for students and

room, wash rooms and water cooler. It is meant for only girl students to spend their spare time. Napi Vend & Napi Burn

Machines are available for girls.

Parking: Separate parking areas for two wheelers and four wheelers.

Washrooms: Separate washrooms for boys & girls.

Water coolers : Drinking water facility is provided on every floor of each building.

Garden : There is a beautiful, well maintained garden that adds glory to the

campus. The icon of our founder Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil is located at the center of the garden and the stairs cascading from

the platform are also used as amphitheater for some cultural

activities.





SUPPORT SYSTEMS

Placement Cell:

This cell organizes campus interviews, career fares and training sessions for students who are in final year of their UG/PG Education and are looking for employment.

Competitive Examination Guidance Cell:

This center provides coaching for the students who are preparing for different competitive examinations like- UPSC, MPSC. A separate study room with relevant books is reserved for this activity.

Counselling Center:

This center helps students with counseling on career issues, personal problems etc.

Women Development Cell & Gender Issue Cell:

Both these cells address issues related to women and gender discrimination. Different activities are organized to promote talents in girl students and develop a sense of pride and equality in them.

Special Cell:

This cell is specially initiated to help students belonging to socially backward classes of the society. The cell informs the concerned students about the various Government schemes and Scholarships.

Grievance Redressal Cell:

Complaints and grievances of students, staff and faculty members are handled by this cell. Boxes are placed at different locations to receive complaints. The issues are solved with the help of concerned departments and committees under the guidance of Principal by maintaining the compete anonymity.

Sexual Harassment Redressal Cell:

This is to prevent and address any incident of sexual harassment in the campus. The cell has definite redressal system designed as per the Government directives.

Student Council & Welfare Cell:

This cell is run by student representatives of different classes and is guided by faculty members. The activities of this cell are designed to inculcate leadership qualities among students. It also undertake some welfare activities like raising funds for poor students and mitigate their problems.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

National Service Scheme: The College has very active unit of NSS which organizes different activities that alleviate sense of patriotism, social obligation, environment consciousness and dignity of labor among students.

Cultural Activities: "ART CIRCLE" organizes various events to promote performing and literary talents among students. Participation in University festivals and intercollegiate events is facilitated by this committee.

Sports Activities: The College has Gymkhana Committee which organizes annual sports events, Karmaveer Marathon and promotes sports talent among students. Facilities for outdoor as well as indoor games are provided. Students who exhibit extraordinary proficiency in sports at national and international level are honoured with special awards and financial help.

Skill Development Programs: There is a Skill Development Committee specially appointed to organize variety of training programs for faculty, staff and students. Commonly arranged trainings are: Soft Skill Development, Computer literacy, Effective Communication etc.

DISCIPLINE & CODE OF CONDUCT

DISCIPLINE

- Self-Discipline is the best discipline. All students are expected to observe rules and regulations currently in force to enable the smooth working of the college.
- Students are prohibited to do anything inside or outside the college that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image. No outside influence, political or of any other type should be brought to the college directly or indirectly.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- In case of any problem, personal or academic, students should report to the Prof-incharge of their respective class, Junior College Supervisor or the Vice-Principal, who will help them in solving their difficulties.
